Steve Grossman Endorses Becca Rausch, Progressive Democrat for State Senate
Local, State, and National Endorsers Steadily Backing Becca to Unseat Republican Incumbent

(Needham, MA) – Steve Grossman, former Massachusetts State Treasurer and Chair of the Democratic National Committee, has endorsed Becca Rausch for MA State Senate. “Her passion for public service and her deep commitment to inclusive prosperity make Becca the best candidate to serve the people of the Norfolk, Bristol & Middlesex District and work in a collegial, collaborative way to address the unmet needs of every resident,” he said.

Grossman’s is the latest in a string of high-profile endorsements that Becca, a lawyer and elected Needham Town Meeting member, has received in her run to flip Scott Brown’s former State Senate seat. Nationally, she has been endorsed by Run For Something, an organization that recruits and supports strong voices in the next generation of progressive leadership; and received the Gun Sense Candidate Distinction from Moms Demand Action For Gun Sense in America, a grassroots organization that is part Everytown for Gun Safety, the largest gun violence prevention organization in the country.

NAGE/SEIU National President, David Holway, said in support of the Local 5000 endorsement of Becca, “[a]s a union steward and a lawyer for the Commonwealth of MA, Becca has demonstrated that she shares our values and is dedicated to creating a more just and humane society. We are proud to stand with her for her primary election.”

Locally, Becca has been endorsed by Needham Select Board members Dan Matthews (Chair), John Bulian (Vice Chair), and Moe Handel (Secretary), and Michael Greis, Needham School Committee Member. Jon Saxton, former chair of the Wayland Democratic Town Committee and long-time activist, sits on Becca’s Campaign Committee.

In addition to these recognitions, Becca has also taken 350 Mass Action’s “No Fossil Fuel Money” pledge promising to “prioritize the health of our families, climate, and democracy over fossil fuel industry profits” and the “No NRA Money” pledge. The Republican incumbent is rated A by the NRA and the Gun Owners Action League of MA.
